



CIRCULAR TO ALL GTA MEMBERS

During a press conference held today, the Minister for Tourism and Consumer Protection, Hon Clayton Bartolo announced that all licensed operators by the Malta Tourism Authority in the tourism sector will benefit from the second licenses scheme, which is expected to reach €4 million.

This scheme covers the cancellation of all the payments and licenses of contributions payable to the MTA for the entire 2021. This means that the license fees and contributions for this year 2021 payable to the MTA are being cancelled for the year.

The list of businesses to benefit from this license fee waiver are the following:

Hotels, guest houses, hostels, holiday furnished premises, host families, restaurants, bars, travel agents, tourist villages, diving snack bars, take-aways, kiosks, water sports, night clubs, self-drive, self-drive motorcycles, pleasure boats, coaches, mini-buses, taxis, garage hire, souvenir shops, timeshares and language schools.
